MEATACHANUPHATUM School for the poor is a government recognized Christian school operated by Mercy International [House of Mercy Foundation] and located adjacent to the Ban Meata Children's Village. 1500 students are enrolled, which includes over 1000 children from poorer families within the local community and from 19 surrounding villages. With some Government help children receive a free education, free uniforms, free transport, daily hot lunches and other benefits.
